This year the project team has been focused on consultation to develop the detail of the internal building spaces and the landscape. There has been a lot of engagement with Council Officers, school staff and students from Currie High and the surrounding primary schools.

Pre-planning public consultation was held between April and May on Council's consultation hub and at three live online consultation events on 20-22 April 2021 where the design team presented the proposals so far. The team involved in the project answered questions asked by the attendees.

The full planning application for the school will be submitted over the summer with the consultation period timed to take place once the schools return in August.

The new 3G pitch will be created ahead of the rest of the new school building to ensure that there is no loss of curricular PE provision during the build.

The new pitch works will begin late August at the earliest and final details on construction timelines, access arrangements etc. will be shared at the start of the new term.

The pitch works are expected to take 18 weeks. As with all term-time construction projects, the contractor will work closely with the headteacher and senior leadership team to ensure the safety of users on site.
